SERVICE DELIVERY APPROACH

ISI conducts a field survey of the facility for the purpose of developing a station layout, flow plan, pole/drapery privacy plan for soldier processing. Based upon a government approved logistics plan, ISI will set up the examination stations in keeping with OSHA, State and Federal regulations in the following manner:

- ISI logistics support personnel will ship the portable medical equipment and supplies to the exam site where they will be set up by the advance team. The advance team consists of the ISI Senior Project Manager, Site Lead and On-Site Medical Director.
- Advance personnel will set up and test all equipment. Spare equipment will be provided for all critical and sensitive functions.
- The evening before the event the Site Lead will conduct a run-through and refresher training for all medical staff on procedures and paperwork.
